### *A beautiful resource – our own Case Lake*

As summer approaches, the Town Board wants to remind you of the availability to rent the Case Lake area for family picnics, weddings and friendly gatherings. The area is a beautiful place to enjoy lunch and share the playground area with your children.

The shelter area can be reserved by completing a form and paying a rental fee of \$50 with the Town Clerk. Summer dates are reserved quickly, so reserve your date as soon as possible.

As always, we encourage safety when using the playground, shelter and grill areas. We want to remind users that swimming is never allowed at Case Lake.

All pets must be leashed at all times and no glass containers are allowed. The area is a take-in, take out site. There are no garbage cans and all users are expected to remove any garbage they produce. Please bring your own garbage bags and waste containers for your pets.

Thank you for observing the rules and making the area safe and beautiful for all of our residents, including area wildlife.

Due to fire risk during the spring months, residential brush burning is prohibited in New York State from March 16 through May 14, 2016.
