### NOTES FROM THE SPW:

As spring arrives so does the season of yard cleanup. The Village has a brush pile where you can bring brush and yard/garden waste for disposal, open from dawn to dusk. There is no garbage allowed in the brush pile, please follow the directions on the posted signs. If you have questions please stop in the office and inquire. This service is for village residents only; not for town/county residents' or contractors' use.

Please remember property owners are responsible for the care and maintenance of sidewalks. If you need to have your sidewalk replaced please contact the Village office to be put on the replacement list.

### NOTES FROM THE POLICE CHIEF:

The police department will be canvassing the village during the month of April looking for un-registered vehicles per Local Law Section 92.01–92.02; a 30 day unregistered vehicle permit can be obtained in the clerks' office at no charge.

### NOTES FROM THE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER:

CEO Allan Fish will be canvassing the village as well looking for dilapidated accessory buildings (sheds, garages etc.) and junk per NYS safe buildings law.

CEO Fish would like to remind everyone of the local law prohibiting high grass and weeds: Section 95.01–95.03 stating that lawns are to not have grass or weeds exceeding 6 inch height after May 15<sup>th</sup>. Please adhere to this policy as it will be enforced by the code officer.

We have had a few inquiries regarding large garbage collection, at this time the Village of Franklinville has no such collection scheduled. If you have large items that need to be disposed of you can purchase a dump ticket and take the items to the transfer station located on Rt 16 North.
