Reports from Department Heads-

Chief Slavinski said things are quiet, there is still no court in session due to the pandemic.

Clerk Sage- Trustee Sikora moved, 2nd Trustee Hillman to cancel the May 25, 2020 meeting due to the Memorial Day holiday. All ayes. Motion carried. Trustee Schumaker moved, 2nd by Trustee Hillman to give Clerk Sage permission to pay the regular monthly bills. All ayes. Motion carried.

Reports from Board members:

Trustee Schumaker announced that the income survey is officially completed, and we have met the criteria to be eligible to apply for future CDBG grants. She thanked everyone that helped accomplish this task. The Village of Franklinville will have the data available for the next 5 years.

Trustee Pockey moved, 2nd by Trustee Hillman to approve the bills totaling \$34,028.68 from the General Fund, \$12,610.59 from the Water Fund and \$26,768.52 from the Sewer Fund. All ayes. Motion carried.
