Terms and Conditions

1. **The promoter reserves the right to accept or deny each application.**
2. **Vendor fees are non-refundable.** Submission of vendor fees is not a contract of festival acceptance as this will be a juried event. If a vendor is not accepted, they will receive a refund in full.
3. **All Packaged Food vendors must provide a Certificate of Insurance** with a liability limit of no less than \$1,000,000 and shall name Village of Franklinville and WNY Maple Festival. Request your insurance company to add "Additional Insureds".
4. **If required, accepted vendors will be required to provide a Permit to Operate from the Cattaraugus County Department of Health and are subject to on-site Dept. of Health inspections.**
5. **Applicants will be notified if not accepted. Detailed Festival information will be emailed around mid April.**
6. Refundable \$25 set-up fee * – (these are to be separate checks from the booth fee) is charged for each booth. If you are still up and running at 4:00 pm on SUNDAY, your check(s) for \$25.00 will be returned to you. The committee will start returning set-up checks at 4:00 pm on Sunday. If you have dismantled your booth or display or have otherwise started to "tear down" in any way prior to closing time, your \$25 fee is forfeited in its entirety.
7. **SET-UP** times are as follows:
 - Park Square: Saturday beginning at 7:00 am
 - Gym: Friday: after 6:00 p.m. (NO EXCEPTIONS). Saturday: 7:00 a.m.
 - Outside School: Friday: after 5:00 p.m. Saturday: 7:00 a.m.
 - Inside: Friday: after 5:00 p.m. Saturday: 7:00 a.m
 - Booths must be completely set-up 1 hour prior to opening, 9:00 am, for booth inspection.
8. Booths must be completely set-up 1 hour prior to opening for booth inspection.
9. **NO** vendors or vehicles will be permitted on the grounds after 9am on Saturday or Sunday.
10. No tables and chairs will be provided. Please remember to bring your own.
11. Racks, signs, tables, chairs and displays may not extend more than 2 feet in front of your booth and must not impede traffic flow.
12. **NO** selling will be permitted on the grounds outside of your booth area.
13. **The Festival will go on rain or shine.** This is an outdoor event. Vendors **must** supply a substantial tent or canopy for themselves. In addition, tents **MUST** be properly staked firmly into the ground. Weights on the corners do not suffice in our windy valley.
14. All participants must operate on **Saturday from 10am-5pm**, and **Sunday from 10am-4pm**. No vendor vehicles may return to the grounds until the grounds are cleared of customers.
15. **There will be NO overnight sleeping in your booth or camping.**
16. Your application must be **postmarked by February 28, 2023** for the early reduced fee.
17. Each vendor will be responsible for his/her property. **WNY Maple Festival, Village of Franklinville and/or Franklinville Central School, are not responsible for any damage, theft, or loss for any reason.**
