**State of Emergency Declaration from the Town of Franklinville, New York**


The Town of Franklinville hereby declares a State of Emergency effective at 6:00 pm on Friday, March 20, 2020 and continuing in effect until rescinded. Town Buildings will be closed to the public.

The State of Emergency has been declared due to emergency conditions enacted by the State of New York in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The pandemic threatens or imperils the public safety of the citizens of the Town of Franklinville.

As Town Supervisor, I have exercised the authority given me under New York State Executive Law, Article 2-B, for the purpose of procuring goods and services, and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well being and health of the citizens of the Town of Franklinville.

I hereby direct all departments of the Town of Franklinville to take whatever steps are necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and any other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.
